The purpose of the Thornton Food Bank is to provide free emergency food assistance to those who are truly in need, regardless of age, race or religion.

We can give you the first referral directly at the Food Bank. The second referral must be a written referral from someone such as a school, church or social services. Your request for assistance must be in response to an emergency situation. Our food bank receives assistance from many organizations, both public and private, some of which place restrictions on their contributions. We must pass these restrictions along to you, our clients.

Our food bank serves the area between 58th Ave on the south and 104th Ave on the north; I-25 on the west and the Platte River on the east. Proof of residence in this area will be required. If you do not reside in this area, we will refer you to the proper food bank for your area, as coordinated with Adams County Food Distribution Center.
